W.P.1 Objectives

- 1.1. To get an updated perspective of the current challenges for higher education in Libya and discuss methodologies for the analysis of the higher education sector.
- 1.2. To draft an Evidence-Based Diagnosis document of the current situation of the Libyan Higher Education sector. This document will receive inputs from the results of a previous project (UNIGOV / “Exploring the Challenges for HE in Libya” Report) plus the inputs collected following the methodology agreed in the KOM.

Task 1.1 Methodology

Carrying out the kick-off-meeting of the project and explaining all technical and administrative commitments of the project.

Discussing the results of the UNIGOV project, which will be presented for discussion. Specifically, the report “Exploring the Challenges for HE in Libya” will be presented for discussion

Development of Methodology for Micro and Macro Analysis (questionnaires, interview guides, deskbound research guidelines);

Defining Working Groups in the Consortium according to the topics identified (6 initial Working Groups - 1 participant for each partner);

Task 1.2 Methodology

DEFINITION of a questionnaire on the basis of the topics emerged during the first meeting of the 6 Working groups

SUBMISSION of the questionnaire to identified stakeholders (HEIs, Ministry, others)

COLLECTION of results and drafting of the Evidence-Based Diagnosis document, which will include conclusions and training needs analysis
